Weapons disposal firm uses Clip-n-Seal food storage device to contain hazardous material

Seattle, WA - 05/13/04 - Clip-n-Seal® has landed some unexpected customers for their air- and watertight bag sealing device. Most recent and perhaps most surprising is mmic eod ltd (<http://www.mmic-eod.co.uk/>), an explosive ordnance disposal firm headquartered in the U.K. who is using a special variant of the Clip-n-Seal device in their latest weapons containment equipment.

mmic makes equipment to contain, sample, and neutralize many types of chemical and biological weapons. Some of their products include vapor containment devices, filtration systems, and secure containers for transporting hazardous samples.

The custom Clip-n-Seal is an important part of their system, containing dangerous material while it is transported and analyzed. mmic's Dr. Steve Sales says that adding Clip-n-Seal to their equipment "represents a significant advance in security and protection against weapons of mass destruction."

Dr. Sales also appreciated the help mmic has received from the Clip-n-Seal team: "Our development has been facilitated by the support provided by the Clip-n-Seal team who, despite being surprised by the unconventional use for their product, have been more than helpful and have thus contributed to homeland security in the US and UK."

Clip-n-Seal and mmic agree that this is the most unusual use for Clip-n-Seal so far, but it might be the most important.

Other customized Clip-n-Seals include a 6-foot long Clip-n-Seal used in the furniture veneering process, and a skinny, mini version being tested by a chemical company. Clip n-Seals provide an air- and watertight seal and are typically used to keep food fresh.
